What is an urban heat island?

An urban heat island occurs when a city experiences much warmer temperatures than nearby rural areas. Urban heat island effect can lead to worsened air and water quality, higher electricity costs, and increased susceptability to heat-related illnesses, especially for outdoor workers.

How does heat affect the body?

Heat Exhaustion Symptoms

Cool, moist skin
Heavy sweating
Headache
Nausea or vomiting
Rapid, weak pulse
Muscle cramps

Treatment

Drink water
Get to a cool place
Apply a cold compress



Heat Stroke Symptoms

Confusion, slurred speech Loss of consciousness Red, hot, and dry skin High body temperatures Rapid, strong pulse Seizures


Treatment

Stay with the person until help arrives


How do you prevent heat-related illnesses?
