Jennifer graduated from Delaware Valley College with a B.S. in Large Animal Science. After graduation, she worked for Hershey Ag for three years in one of their farrow to feeder operations. For the past eighteen years she has worked at Bell & Evans. She started out as a Flock Technician/Flock Supervisor. She performed the HAACP testing on all the farms and was responsible for supervision of eight to ten farms. She quickly worked up to fulltime Flock Supervisor. Six years later she was promoted to Growout Territory Manager and was responsible for two to three flock supervisors and all the farms in the Eastern Territory of the Bell & Evans broiler growout. The last six years she has been Broiler Manager. She is currently responsible for the entire broiler division encompassing on average 50 million chickens a year. Early in her career at Bell & Evans she was asked to get involved with environmental issues such as nutrient management, CAOs and CAFOS. She was the PEACCE coordinator for Bell & Evans until the program was shut down. In the past few years she has been serving on the Nutrient Management Subcommittee of the USDA NRCS State Technical Committee for Pennsylvania and recently the Phase 3 WIP Ag Workgroup for Pennsylvania.
