

Revised Proposed Language to Accompany the Phase 6 Nutrient Management BMP Expert Panel's Report

The Chesapeake Bay Program partners will provide for a 3-year transition period for the six states to carry out the programmatic, policy and legislative changes necessary to track, verify and report nutrient management consistent with the recommendations in the Phase 6 Nutrient Management BMP Expert Panel's report. Through their two-year milestones, each of the six states will commit to taking specific steps over that timeframe as clear demonstrations of their commitment to evolve their BMP tracking, verification and reporting systems to be consistent with the Panel's recommendations by 2019 Progress.
