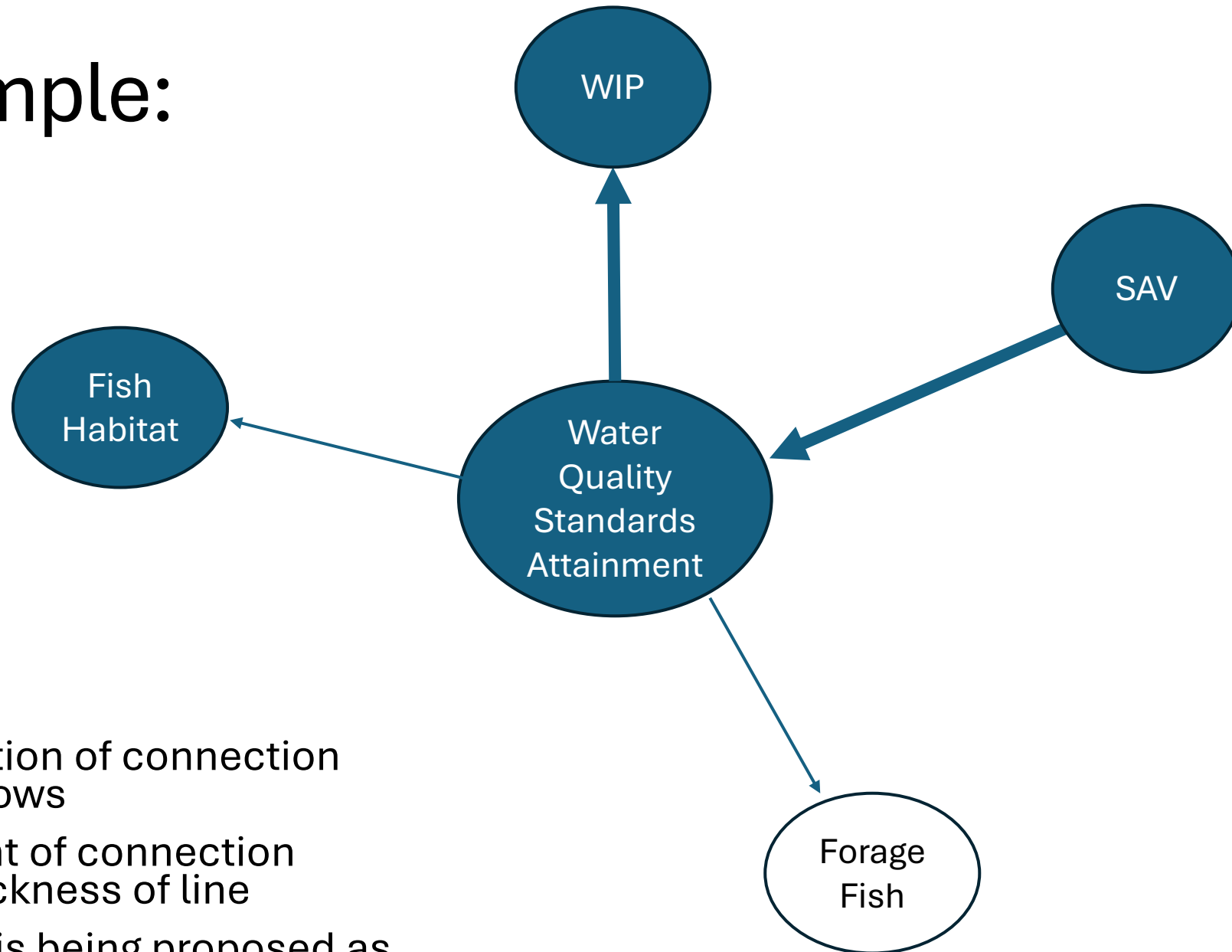
Homework Assignment

- Build out an outcome mind – map(s): diagram to visually organize information and show relationship among pieces
 - How does your proposed outcome connect with other outcomes?
- Base the mind-map on your proposed outcome (2-pagers)
 - Include text or do an additional mind-map on other scenarios/relationships based on feedback from Management Board
- This does not need to be a masterpiece! Start with the template, but make it work for you! Overall, just help others visually understand how your outcome overlaps with others.

Use of Mind-Map

- During meeting you will have 5 minutes to show your mind-map and describe it to participants. Items to consider (not mandatory) when verbally sharing your mind-map during the meeting:
 - Where does your outcome overlap with other outcomes?
 - How is your outcome distinct?
 - Does your outcome fit as an output for other outcomes?
 - Do other outcomes fit as an output for your outcome?

Suggestions:

- Show direction of connection through arrows
- Show weight of connection through thickness of line
- If outcome is being proposed as an output, don't fill in the circle
