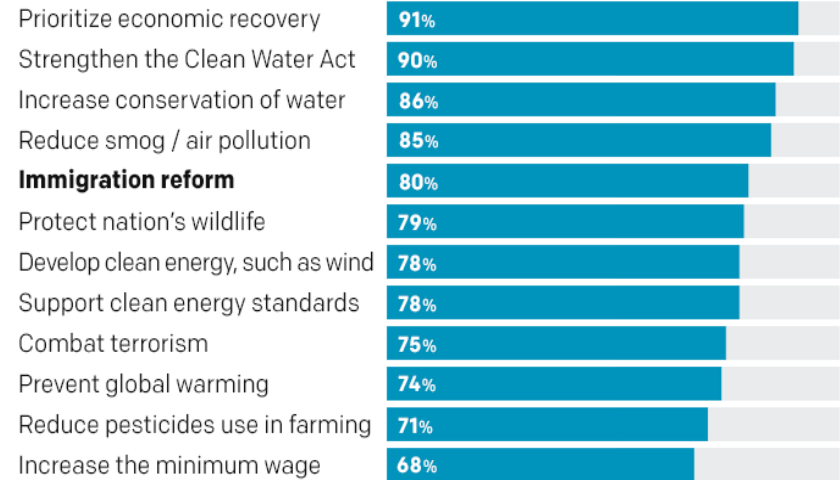
DEIJ Survey Results

83% of environmental organizations hold DEI as a core value yet only 9% consider their DEI processes effective.

Ethnic Minorities and the Environment

Greater Concern

- ★ 68% of minority voters polled feel that climate change is an immediate problem to address.¹
- ★ Latinos are more concerned with climate change than non-Latinos. **Spanish-language Latinos are even more concerned.**²
- ★ Environmental issues are as important as the passage of comprehensive immigration reform.³

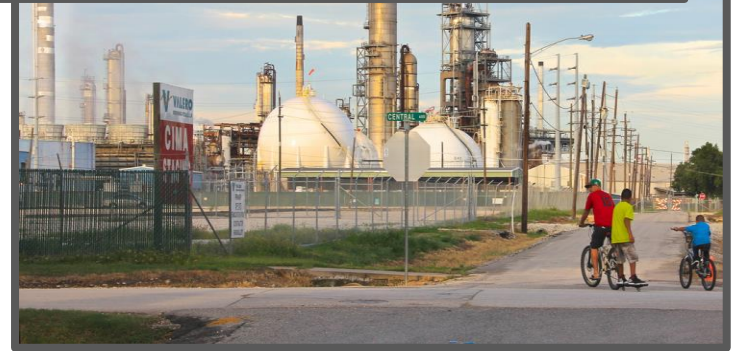

Ethnic Minorities and the Environment

Disproportionate Burdens

- ★ More exposed to air pollutants and hazardous land uses.¹
 - Poor quality housing with old heating systems and poor insulation
- ★ Less tree canopy in lower income neighborhoods.²
- ★ Vulnerability to health impacts from climate change.³
 - More asthma, cancer, Covid, neurological diseases
- ★ Globally, climate change is driving human migration and displacement.⁴



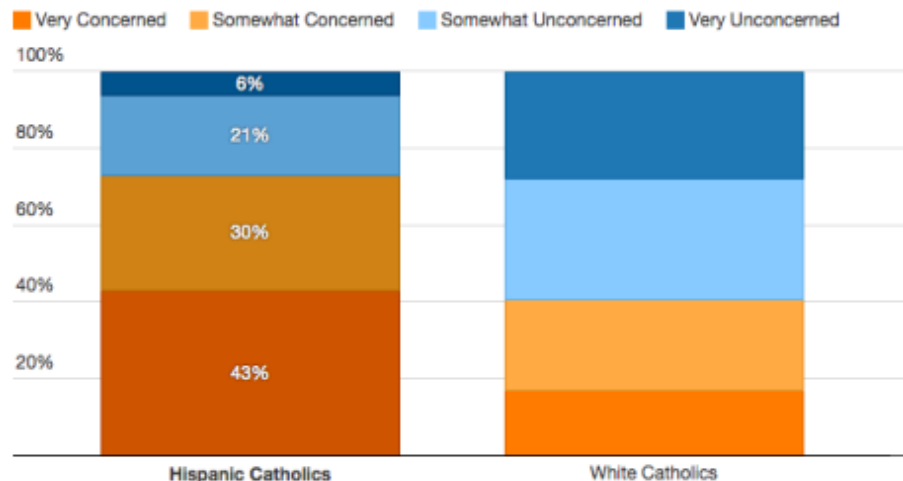

Seven in ten Latinos (71%) have never been contacted by an organization working to reduce global warming.

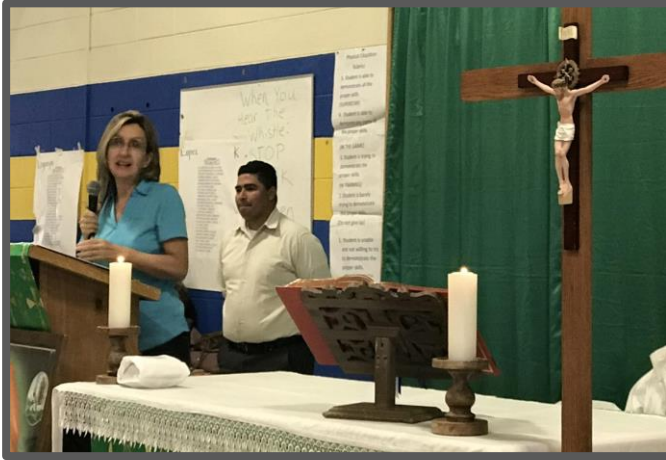
Environmental Justice

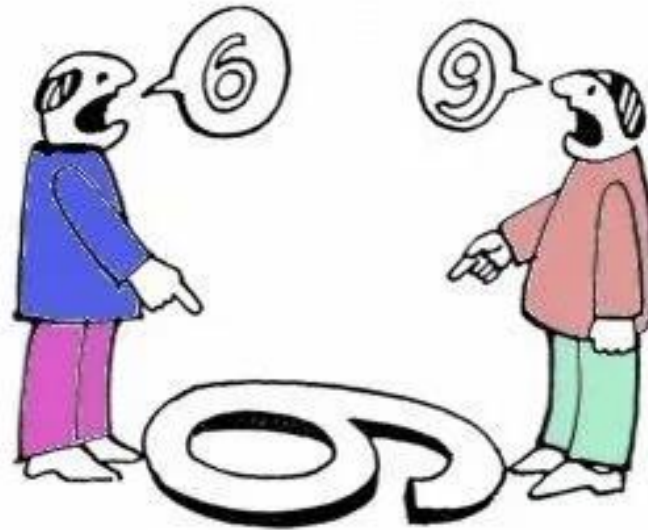

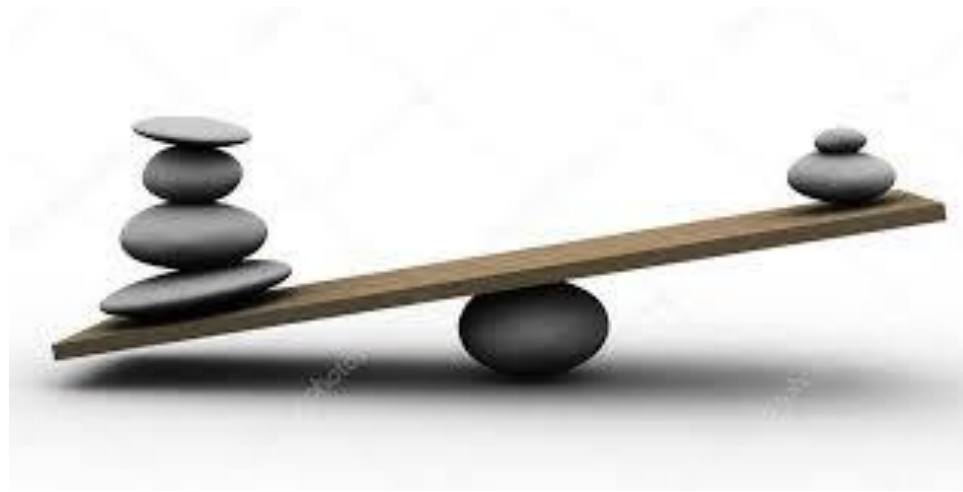
