Supporting Documents	Purpose
Logic & Action Plan	Illustrates the links between the factors that cause impacts towards an outcome and the actions it takes to manage them.
Narrative Analysis	Indicates whether an outcome has changed and whether its actions are having their intended effect.
Presentation	Summarizes the information in the Logic and Actions Plan and Narrative Analysis.

# Open Discussion

**Looking back over the last two years describe any scientific (including the impacts of climate change) fiscal, and policy-related developments that impacts your progress or may influence your work over the next two years:**

## **Examples:**

- **Fiscal** – increases in funding for land conservation, enhanced state funding, BUT challenges with capacity, applying for funding, and managing projects.
- **Policy** – New administration has implemented supporting policies, executive orders have increased federal partnership, BUT challenges with staff capacity, and finding ways to plan effectively and towards a collective action.
- **Scientific** – Growing science confirms the need for conservation, predictions and data are used to support initiatives BUT challenges with development and establishing stewardship related to land conservation.

# Open Discussion

**Summarize what you have learned over the past two years. What has shown great success for land conservation and what hasn't. Are there gaps to fill or factors to consider?**

## **Examples:**

- Understanding limited personnel and programmatic capacity influences the ability to administer and manage funding for land conservation.
- Population increases and need for economic gains have caused development pressures and competition.

**Looking ahead for the next two years, what do you see as promising opportunities or developments in the conservation field that will accelerate progress?**
