Decision: WQGIT leadership will add COVID- 19 updates / impacts as a standing agenda item for the next few monthly meetings.

Action: Hilary will send the revised Climate Change Policy decision and discussion timeline to the WQGIT members after the meeting.

Decision: The WQGIT decided (pending CBF's review) to not include open water for the whole column with the option to revisit CB6 and CB7 as part of the Climate Change Policy allocation options.

Action: Prior to the May 26th WQGIT meeting, members should review the climate change documents (see [April WQGIT](#) meeting page) and provide feedback to Gary Shenk on the following allocation options:

- Include responsibility for WWTP loads
- Reduce watershed loads first and allocate the rest
- 2025 or 2035

Action: Lew Linker and Gary Shenk will put together a document that explains the path forward for anticipated changes to the shallow water modeling.

Action: The Management Board charged the WQGIT with forming a BMP Verification Ad- Hoc action team. These meetings will potentially be held the 2nd Monday of the month. WQGIT members and the Advisory Committees are asked to identify a representative to serve on this ad-hoc action team by COB May 15, 2020.
