

# 2011 Milestones to Reduce Nitrogen & Phosphorus Interim Progress Assessment June 2011

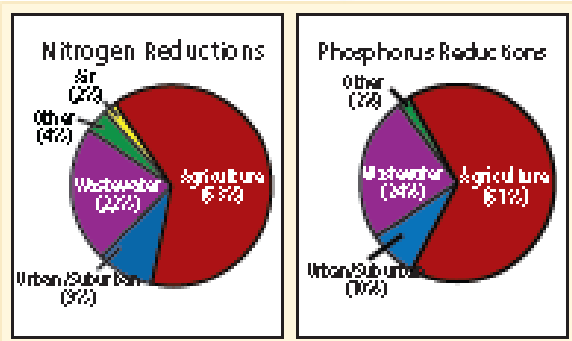


## Introduction

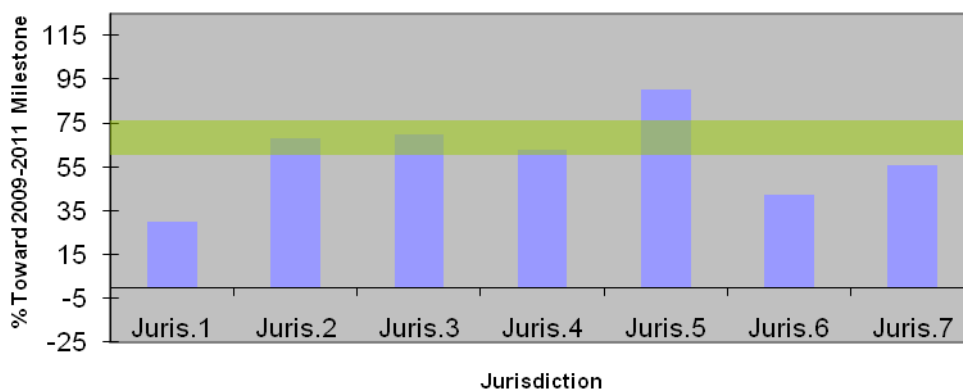
During the 2009 Chesapeake Executive Council meeting, the governors of the Bay watershed jurisdictions - Maryland, Virginia, Pennsylvania, Delaware, West Virginia, New York and the District of Columbia - set short-term goals to reduce pollution to the Bay and dramatically accelerate the pace of restoration. The collective jurisdictional commitments will result in reducing nitrogen by 15.8 million pounds and phosphorus by 1.05 million pounds during the three-year period, 2009-2011. As of 2010, the jurisdictions are [on-track, ahead/behind schedule] to meet these commitments. See below for an interim assessment of progress.

### Pollution Reductions by Source



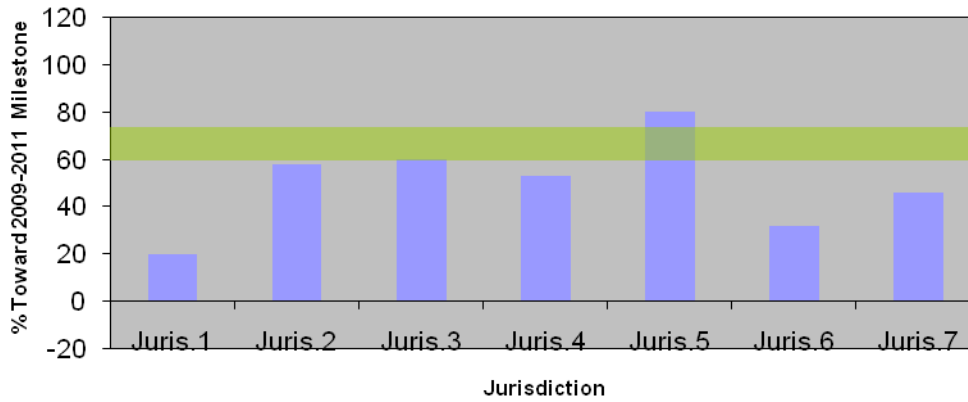

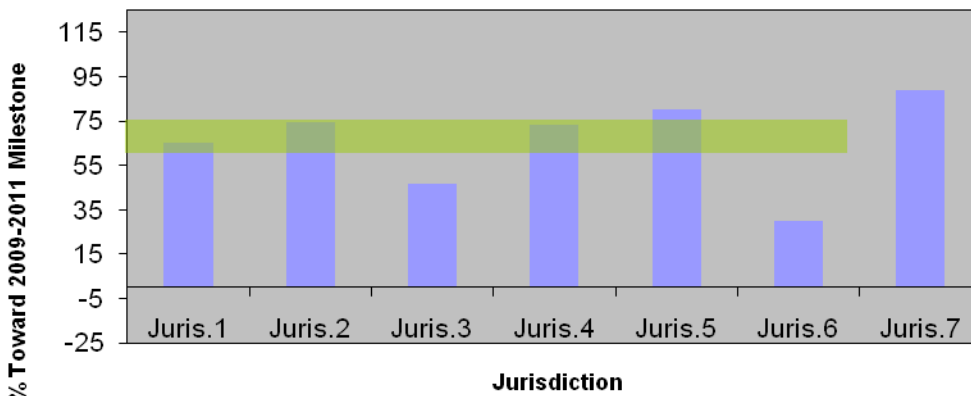
