
Corrections to Urban and Construction for 2015 Progress

- CBP typically removes estimates of construction acres from estimates of urban acres. This was not done for 2015.
- The correction resulted in less than 1% difference in urban acres in each state.
- States will have another opportunity to review land use projections this October following submission of afo/cafo splits and harvested forest lands.
- Looking for approval to make this correction as the land use was already approved for the 2015 Milestones.



Double Cropped Crops

- Total double cropped area is determined as the sum of crops below.
- Each of the two groups are double cropped with each other and assigned to the small grain and soybean land use.
- Acres of crops that are not double cropped remain in their original land use.

Crop Group 1

- Corn for Grain Harvested Area
- Corn for silage or greenchop
 Harvested Area
- Sorghum for Grain Harvested Area
- Sorghum for silage or greenchop Area
- Soybeans for beans Harvested Area

Crop Group 2

- Barley for grain Harvested Area
- Buckwheat Harvested Area
- Canola Harvested Area
- Emmer and spelt Harvested Area
- Oats for grain Harvested Area
- Rye for grain Harvested Area
- Triticale Harvested Area
- Wheat for Grain Harvested Area
