## Spatial and Temporal Wetland Outcomes

- 1. Referential to historic area: areas of wetlands precolonial. Maybe a percentage.
  - a) by jurisdiction
  - b) by physiographic province
- 2. Historic reference + projected losses
- 3. Achievement of ecosystem services- rolled up
  - a) Lbs pollutant removal using approved BMPs (set to percentage of remaining reductions needed)
  - b) Minimal area for black duck current populations
  - c) Increased area for black duck
  - d) Area based on blue crab, anadromous fish habitat
  - e) Areal extent for flood benefits (consider open space NFIP CRS credits)

- 4. Distribution by jurisdiction, physiography, stream order (floodplain, isolated)
- 5. Referential to existing + projected losses
- 6. Referential to community need
  - a) High risk for flooding
  - b) subsistence fishing/hunting
  - c) Cultural importance
  - d) Increase/ maximize wetland complexes
- 7. Referential/ consider WIPs (we know these numbers have decreased... and there is a category wet ponds/ wetlands that nobody seems to understand)
