Invasive Catfish Occurrences in Delaware

Flathead Catfish

DE River Drainage – 1 confirmed report (2010)

rrivate Pond – illegal stocking (2015)

Blue Catfish

DE River Drainage- 2 confirmed reports (2013, 2015)

Choptank River Drainage – 1st observed in 2015

✓ Nanticoke River Drainage- reports began in 2015





State Record 36lbs 3.2oz, upper Nanticoke River, Seaford, DE

Gear Type and Trends



- Division of Fish and Wildlife: data on invasive catfish is incidental to other sampling efforts
- Commercial Fishery: landings are mandatory but catfish are not parsed by species and not always the target
- Recreational Anglers: hook & line catch reports are random
