LGAC Recommendations to Executive Council

According to the CBP Governance document,

"the Management Board will Respond to Advisory Committee annual recommendations, letters and reports in writing, within 90 days of receipt, which may be extended an additional 30 days at the request of the MB Chair. Advisory Committee recommendations may be assigned by the MB to the appropriate GIT or Workgroup for consideration of response."

LGAC Recommendations to Executive Council

 The Bay Program is in the process of identifying subject matter experts to provide feedback to the Management Board on the recommendations.

• The strategy for responding to recommendations will be discussed at the upcoming Management Board.

 Management Board will provide a response to the recommendations to advisory committees within 90-120 days from the EC meeting.

Landscape Assessment

2022 GIT funded project to:

- Inventory existing career/workforce programs and the types of career pathways supported by these programs.
- Describe how agencies & organizations intersect with these career/workforce programs to provide <u>pathways from these programs</u> <u>to jobs</u>.
- Identify <u>barriers in this system for underrepresented individuals</u> and suggestions for addressing them.
- Review of <u>labor market data</u> related to green/clean careers and how this can be used to inform program development and decisionmaking.

2025 and Beyond

- The Executive Council charged the Principals' Staff Committee (PSC) in recommending a critical path forward that prioritizes and outlines the next steps for meeting the goals and outcomes of the *Watershed Agreement* leading up to and beyond 2025.
- The PSC is to report back to the Executive Council at their 2023 annual meeting with recommendations on how to best address and integrate new science and restoration strategies leading up to 2025.
- At the 2024 EC annual meeting, the PSC is to prepare recommendations that continue to address new advances in science and restoration, along with a focus on our partnership for going beyond 2025.
- PSC was tasked to consider Science, Restoration and Partnership within these recommendations.
- CBP is currently developing strategy to execute EC charge to the PSC and a draft approach and schedule for developing these recommendations will be shared at the upcoming PSC meeting on December 19th for discussion.

CBP 40th Anniversary

- The Bay Program is in the process of organizing a committee to plan activities and events to celebrate the 40th anniversary of the Chesapeake Bay Program partnership.
- The CBP Communications Team is seeking representatives from each jurisdiction to be a part of the planning.
- This planning committee will kick off their planning in early 2023.
