Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act 00 (IIJA)

- CBPO: \$238 million over 5 years
- \$47.6 M each year
- Other EPA additional infrastructure funding (https://www.epa.gov/infrastructure/fact-sheet-epa-bipartisan-infrastructure-law)
- Other agencies also included
- Presentation to the Management Board
 - Matrix that provides a picture of funding/agencies/outcomes

IIJA - Agencies' Internal Actions

- Law passed in November
- Agencies coordinate with OMB, Congress
- Waiting for guidance, to include:
 - Reporting requirements
 - Separate grants
 - Potential match waiver
- Directed to fund Innovative Nutrient and Sediment Reduction
 Grants, Small Watershed Grands and Most Effective Basins
