- EJ screen will assist GITs & workgroups determine restoration, conversation, planning, targeting priorities.
- Tool will provide implementation information to diverse community groups.

Next Steps for Environmental Justice Screen Pilot

- Bay Trust request for proposals 10/16
- EJ Project screen begins 1/17
- Process:
 - Awardee hires web mapping expert 2/17
 - Diversity workgroup and mapping expert meet with pilot outcome workgroups to explore and prioritize content and mapping - 2/17
 - Develop draft screening tool and present back to pilot outcome workgroup – 6/17
 - ► Final EJ Screen Tool 10/17
- Priority for diversity workgroup is to assure this tool meets needs of underrepresented communities.
- Diversity workgroup would like to further engage climate resiliency workgroup to identify specific needs, initiatives and trusted leaders related to resiliency for underrepresented communities.
