- 1. Revisions to the 2014 Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement, not a new Agreement. - 2. It is the expectation of the Chesapeake Executive Council that the revised partnership structure and processes will be more inclusive of all communities and more manageable for partnership staff.
