#### Vandiver Inn

301 S Union Ave, Havre De Grace, MD 21078

#### Follow S Union Ave and Otsego St to N Juniata St

2 min (0.8 mi)

- -Head west on Fountain St toward S Union Ave
- -Turn right at the 1st cross street onto S Union Ave
- –S Union Ave turns left and becomes Otsego St

#### Follow MD-155 W and MD-161 N to Old Quaker Rd in Darlington

18 min (12.2 mi)

- -Turn right onto N Juniata St
- -Turn left onto Superior St
- -Continue straight onto MD-155 W/Superior St
- -Turn right onto MD-161 N

#### Take Shuresville Rd to Shures Landing Rd

6 min (2.6 mi)

-Turn right onto Old Quaker Rd

- -Turn right onto Shuresville Rd
- -Slight left to stay on Shuresville Rd
- -Turn right
- -Turn left onto Shures Landing Rd

## **Arrive at Conowingo Fisherman's Park**

2569 Shures Landing Rd, Darlington, MD 21034

Turn left and head all the way back to the Pavilion. You may park anywhere in the surrounding parking lot.
