


# How to manually select a breakout group on Webex:

1. When the breakout session starts, those that are pre-assigned to a group will be taken to their breakout group automatically; however, if you are a floater you will remain in the main meeting room until you select a group to join. A box will pop up on the top right of your screen, giving you the option to "choose a session". Click "choose a session".





2. Once you have selected "choose a session" a window will pop up allowing you to select one of the 4 breakout sessions. Choose the session you want to join by clicking the green "join" button.





3. Once you enter a breakout group, you will see which group you have joined in the top right corner of your screen. If you would like to change breakout groups, click "choose a session" and follow the same instructions in step 2 to join a group.
