



FY 2024 EPA Chesapeake Bay Operating Budget








Jurisdiction Implementation Grants

SWG Community Capacity Building Grants

- Builds the capacity of frontline organizations working collaboratively on community and watershed health goals
- \$13M over four years (\$3.5M for FY24)
- Administered by the Chesapeake Bay Trust


