# \$1.5 Billion to Expand Tree Canopy and Access to Nature



#### Inflation Reduction Act (IRA) Investment Timeline





- Aug 2022 = IRA Passed, **\$1.5 billion** investment authorized
- April 2023 = \$250 million investment in state forestry agencies announced, Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) released
- June 2023 = 842 applications received reflecting over
  \$6.4 billion in requests
- August 2023 = completed rigorous review of all applications
- September 2023 = announced \$1.13 billion to 385 projects in all 50 states, territories, islands, and tribes





#### 12 awards, \$270 million investment

- 80% invested directly in local projects
- \$216 million pass-through portfolio
- 56% pass-through portfolio announced
- \$20 million set-aside for tribal and faith-based projects
- Awards range in size from \$5 million to \$50 million
