
Nutrient Application Eligibility

The Chesapeake Assessment Scenario Tool (CAST) simulates nutrient applications onto Agricultural lands.


A <u>specific file</u> within this tool restricts the time in which applications can occur as well as the source of nutrients.

Some of the state inputs to this file have created unrealistic nutrient applications.

Visualizing Manure Eligibility




Example: *Current* application to a manure eligible land use




What happens if you still have manure?

- Manure must still be distributed within the county.
- Manure ends up going to other crops in levels that do not necessarily occur in real life.

Current Version <u>without</u> excess manure relative to crop need Current Version <u>with</u> excess manure relative to crop need







Nutrient Eligibility: The Proposed Fix

Global change made to make all crops that had at least one timing eligible for manure and inorganic nutrients.

Restrictions on nutrient eligibility are not enforced.

An example of the proposed solution:





Scenarios

Data show the most recent Phase 3 WIP with climate change for the Chesapeake Bay watershed area only (CBWS) for 2025

Changes had a minimal effect on loads in any state or scenario

Differences are due to the specifics in each county for crop types and nutrients available throughout the modeling time frame

Any increase in loads is expected to be addressed post-2025 in the unaccounted additional loads (UALs) approved by the PSC

TN Comparison and Impact on WIP

- Units are pounds per year of total nitrogen delivered to the edge of tidal area (EOT) for all sources
- All changes were less than 1% of the total WIP load
