Fertilizer Expert Group DRAFT Recommendations April 2023

Phase 6

- 1. The group has recommended that state-reported fertilizer sales tonnage be used from 2017 onward if available data from states makes up at least 50% of the historic fertilizer sales within the watershed. (Note* if the above threshold is not met the use of AAPFCO data will continue as the status quo.)
- 2. Provided the conditions of Recommendation #1 are met, the group recommends several possible methods to construct the fertilizer stock for jurisdictions which are unable to produce state data past 2017:
 - a. PREFFERED Calculate the percent change between the previous and current year of cumulative state reported data and apply the percent change in fertilizer to nonreporting states.
 - b. ALTERNATIVE 1 Continue to use the last reported year for states without reported data.
 - c. ALTERNATIVE 2 Use a state-specific trends using the last 15 years of AAPFCO data for states without reported data.
- 3. Whenever new state reported fertilizer sales tonnage data are available that satisfy the conditions outlined in Recommendation #1, the group recommends these new data will be incorporated into the next update to CAST.

Phase 7

- 4. The group has recommended that for Phase 7 the CBP partnership re-examine the use of both farm and nonfarm categories of fertilizer in calculating fertilizer sales totals for states within the Chesapeake Bay watershed.
- 5. Recommend that the AMT further examine alternative fertilizer data sets.
