- The public comment period for the new Riparian Forest Buffer Logic & Action plan has ended. We only received one comment from CBF, suggesting that we propose piloting "turnkey" CREP RFB programs. This was added as Action 2.3.b in the revised Logic & Action Plan. The Management Board will be asked to accept this Logic & Action Plan as final at their April 13th meeting.
- At the April 13th Management Board meeting, we will also share revised plans for brief "report outs" on state Riparian Forest Buffer Action Strategy implementation (following up from our Quarterly Progress Review meeting). These 5-minute state report outs are currently scheduled for the July 13th Management Board meeting and guidance will be provided.
