- •We liked all the models (many commonalities, not really new) these <u>organizational models</u> can work for the partnership, but <u>they can also fail if we don't work effectively across outcomes</u>
- •Need a clear plan for topics that span across outcomes such as changing environmental cond.
- •For topics with an existing community of practice we want to continue to enhance collaboration. However, don't diminish activities with a reorganization of outcomes and teams. Improve collaboration, but don't break what's working.
- •Focus on 'How we work' vs. 'What we bin together' For <u>operational models</u> form follows function, operational streamlining (joint meetings, topical discussions, geographic case studies, routine meeting read-outs), support partners with more limited capacity.
- •Continue to <u>identify strategies to increase efficiency</u> don't just reduce the number of outcomes
