Purpose

The federal lands data layer is a key input to the Phase 7 watershed model and essential to calculating federal reduction goals. Updating the federal property boundaries is needed as part of the Phase 7 model development to assess federal pollutant loads and allocate responsibility for reducing those loads to the appropriate federal agencies.
