

1. PSC Roles & Responsibilities (pgs 9-10)

- a) Policy Advisors to EC & setting EC meeting agendas,
- b) Setting policy and implementing actions on behalf of the EC,
- c) Responsible for keeping individual EC members briefed, and
- d) Provides policy and program direction to Management Board

2. Membership (pg 10)

- Delegations (8):
 - "high-level state and federal leaders" (Secretary, Director, Commissioner)
 - State & DC Delegations (7) = membership is at discretion of the state /
 DC
 - Federal Delegation (1) = level commensurate with state secretaries
 - All members of state and federal delegations are invited to participate, however, "each delegation is expected to provide one position for decision-making purposes."
- CBC (1) = CBC Executive Director
- Chair = representative of the EC Chair

3. <u>Operations (pgs 10-11)</u>

- Annual priorities are at discretion of Chair with input from members.
- Meetings = at least 3/year, with option for more.
- Chair sets meeting agendas with support by EPA CBPO.
- Agendas must be posted 3 weeks in advance. Decision documents 2 weeks in advance.
- Quorum (in person or virtual) of at least 50% required to make decisions.

4. Decision Making (pgs 21-24)

Throughout the 40 year history of the CBP and through all 4 Agreements, consensus building has and "remains the preferred decision-making approach"

Goals of CBP Consensus Decision-Making are:

- Inclusive
- Participatory
- Cooperative
- Egalitarian and Equitable
- Solution-oriented

4. Decision Making (pgs 21-24)

5 Step "Consensus-Building Process":

- 1. Discussion of the item
- 2. Formation of the proposal
- 3. <u>Call for consensus</u> each member (Delegation) is asked for their position on the "Consensus Continuum"
- 4. Identification and addressing of concerns
- 5. Modification of the proposal

May occur during meeting and/or assigned for interim work and then taken up at next meeting.

Consensus Continuum



Stop

"I do not agree and feel the need to stand in the way of this decision"

Hold

"I believe more work is needed before we make a decision"

Stand Aside

"I trust the group and will not block this decision but need to register my disagreement"

Agreement with Reservations

"I can live with it"

Endorsement

"I like it"

4. Decision Making (pgs 21-24)

If consensus is not reached, 3 options:

- 1. Keep working on it,
- 2. Forward the issue up to the EC for a decision, or
- 3. Decide by super-majority vote at least 7 of 9 PSC members must vote in favor to pass.
