

# Principals' Staff Committee Meeting June 25, 2024

## **Actions/Decisions**

## **Beyond 2025 Steering Committee Report**

- <u>Decision</u>: The Principals Staff Committee (PSC) approves the PSC Chairs' modified schedule for finalizing the Steering Committee Report (SC Report). (See below)
   (Note: The timeline will be tight, and the PSC needs to have the full amount of review time defined in the modified schedule. The Management Board's role for its October 10, 2024 meeting needs to be clearly defined by the PSC at its September 17, 2024 meeting.)
- <u>Decision</u>: The PSC approves the Beyond 2025 Steering Committee for releasing the draft SC Report for public feedback, provided the Steering Committee adds a note to the top of Report, stating that it is a product of the Steering Committee until accepted by the PSC. It should also be noted that the Steering Committee recommendations are for the PSC and it is the PSC charge to make Beyond 2025 recommendations to the EC.
- <u>Decision</u>: The Beyond 25 Steering Committee Report is, remains, and will be clearly and publicly
  presented as a product of the Steering Committee until informed by the public input process and
  subsequently presented and accepted by the PSC.
- <u>Action</u>: At the September 17 PSC meeting, the Co-Chairs will brief the PSC on the public feedback period and any drafting updates. The Steering Committee will make every effort to prepare a final draft by the end of September for PSC acceptance at its October 25 meeting.
- <u>Decision</u>: Once received by the PSC, the PSC may accept as is or make further revisions prior to submission to the EC, which must occur 30 days prior to the EC's 2025 meeting. Considering the current timeline, this means that the PSC will need to make near final decisions at their October 25 meeting in order to submit the final Report and any resulting Directives, Charges, or Affirmations to the EC in early November.

## **Recommendations for New Agricultural Advisory Committee**

- <u>Decision</u>: The PSC concurs with Ag Action Team's three recommendations: 1) establish a CBP Agricultural Advisory Committee (AAC); 2) finalize bylaws that establish the procedures and membership of the AAC; and 3) convene a meeting with EPA Regional Administrator Ortiz to explore budgets and funding to financially support the AAC.
- Action: The PSC directs the Ag Action Team to develop an Executive Council Directive that formally
  establishes the AAC. The Directive will be reviewed and discussed by the PSC at its September 17

meeting and will be brought up for approval at the PSC's October 25 meeting with final adoption by the Executive Council at its December meeting.

## **Executive Council Meeting Planning Update**

• Action: As part of its September 17 meeting discussion on the EC Directive to establish the new AAC, the PSC will be briefed on the existing Advisory Committees' roles and functions.


## **Partnership Monitoring Program**

- <u>Decision</u>: The PSC agreed to create an action team to develop a Phase II funding strategy that addresses vulnerabilities and protects investments in CBP monitoring networks, through assessment and partner coordination. The Action Team will schedule regular check-ins with the PSC (e.g., at least twice per year).
- <u>Action</u>: The PSC requests that each signatory partner send by July 26 a recommendation for action team members to Ken Hyer and Lee McDonnell.
