- January 16, 2024: Jurisdiction/Conowingo/Federal 2022-2023 programmatic progress due
- January 16, 2024: Jurisdiction/Conowingo/Federal 2024-2025 draft programmatic commitments and draft numeric commitments due
 - **OPTION 1:** Submit numeric commitments within the programmatic commitments for the priority BMPs as identified in your WIP
 - **OPTION 2**: Submit numeric commitments as a CAST scenario

Upcoming Due Dates

- January 31, 2024: EPA compiles federal agency programmatic milestone commitments and posts to Federal Leadership website
- January 31, 2024: Jurisdictions/Conowingo milestone commitments and progress posted to their websites
- Within 60 days of submission of draft programmatic milestones OR finalized numeric progress reports, which ever is later EPA provides draft evaluations to jurisdictions, Conowingo Steering Committee, and Federal Agencies
 - 2023 progress will be evaluated with the current version of CAST (CAST-19) as agreed upon by the CBP partnership
