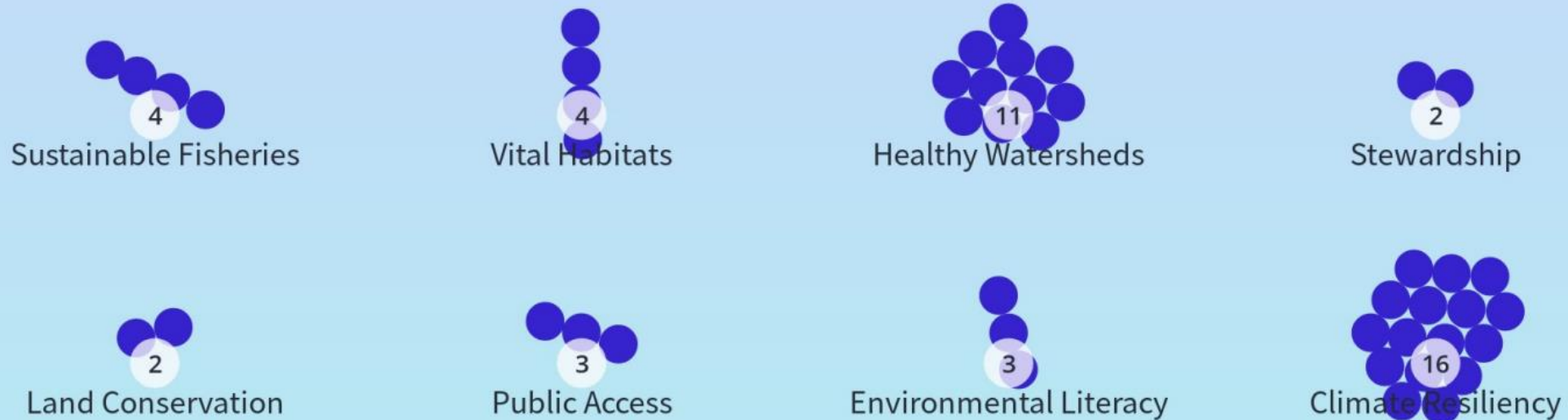

Which CBP core networks and associated recommendations is your organization most interested in supporting and investing? (You may choose more than 1)



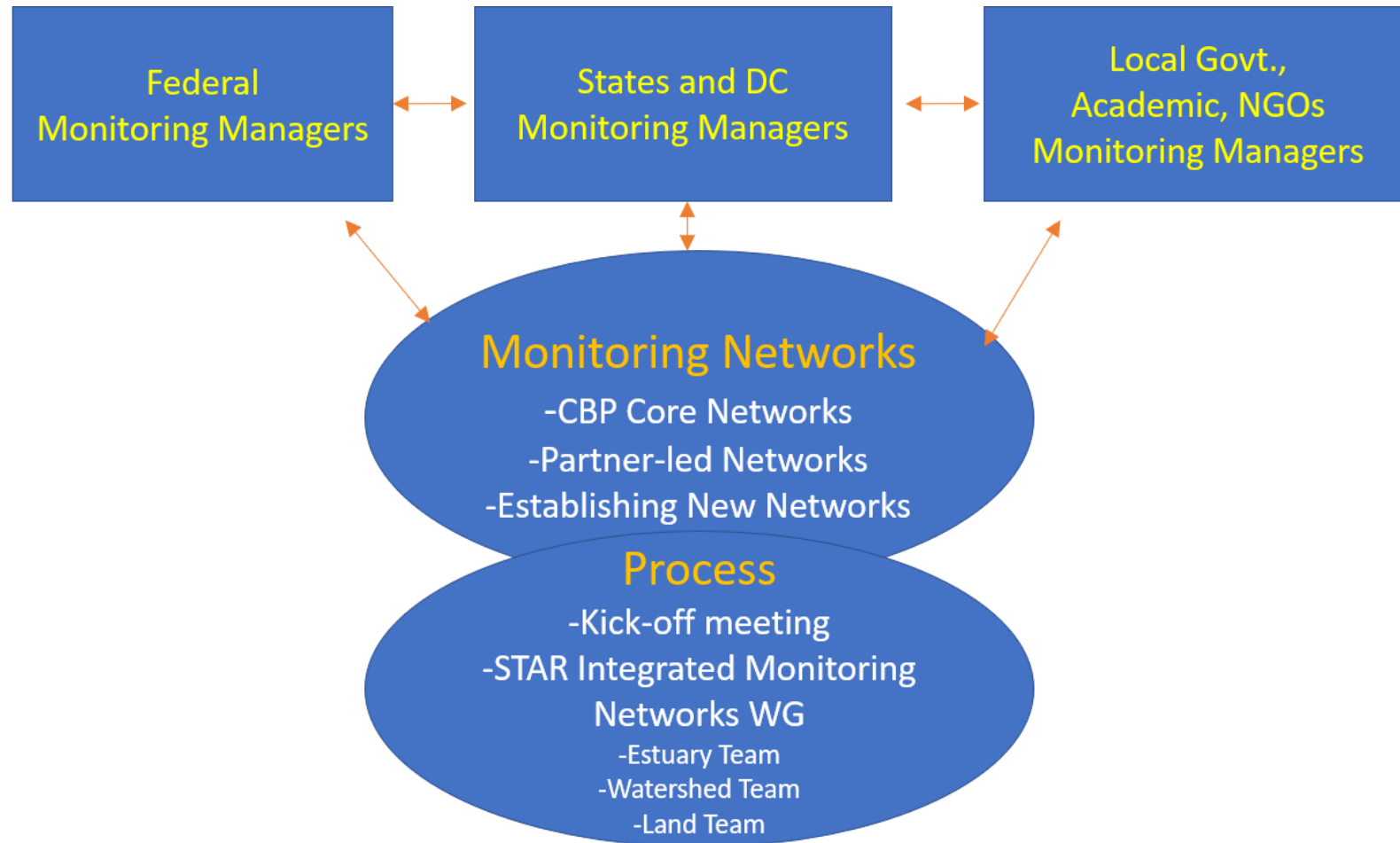
Results from December Webinar
