

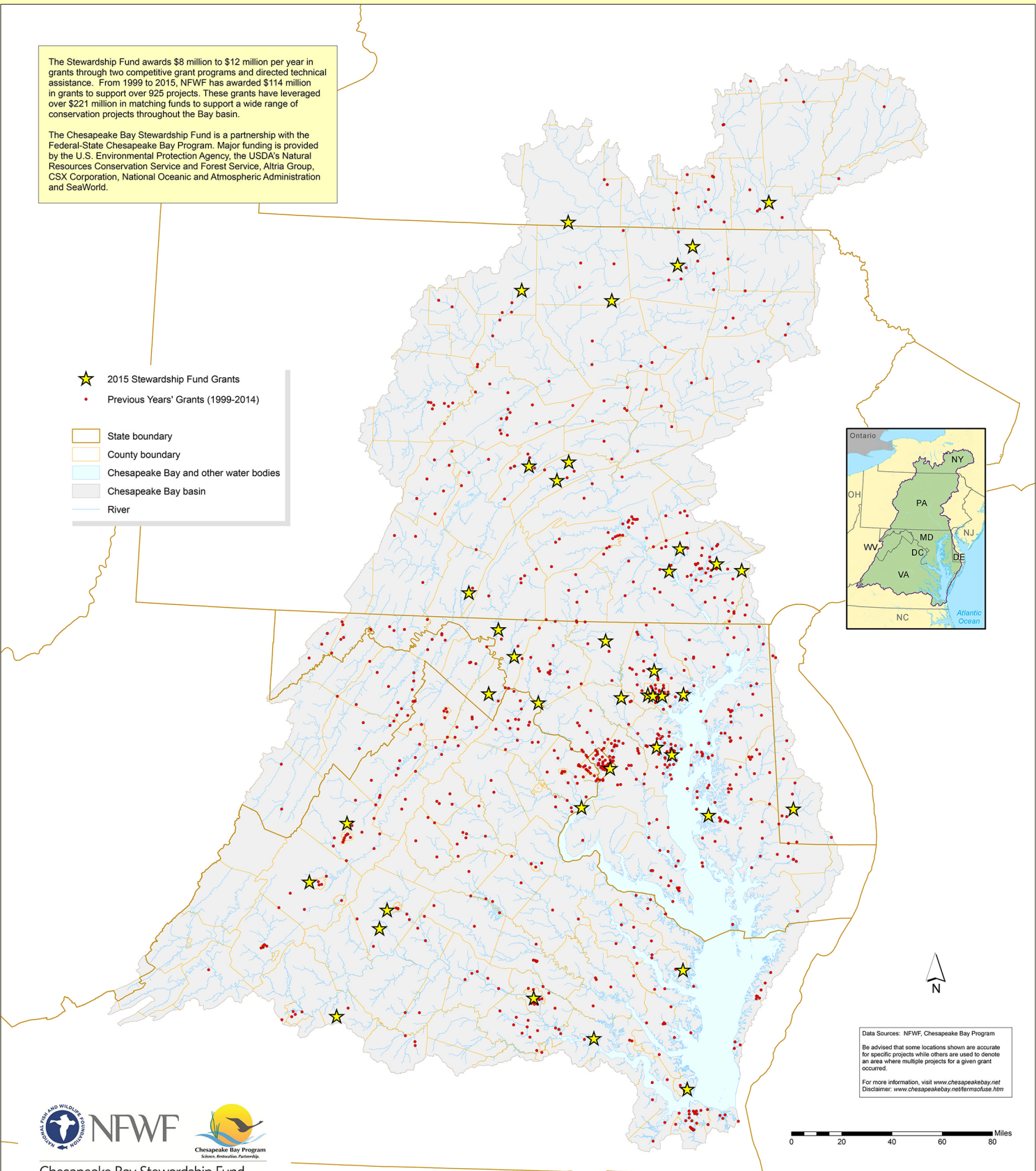
Chesapeake Bay Stewardship Fund Grants 1999-2015

The Stewardship Fund awards \$8 million to \$12 million per year in grants through two competitive grant programs and directed technical assistance. From 1999 to 2015, NFWF has awarded \$114 million in grants to support over 925 projects. These grants have leveraged over \$221 million in matching funds to support a wide range of conservation projects throughout the Bay basin.

The Chesapeake Bay Stewardship Fund is a partnership with the Federal-State Chesapeake Bay Program. Major funding is provided by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, the USDA's Natural Resources Conservation Service and Forest Service, Altria Group, CSX Corporation, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and SeaWorld.
