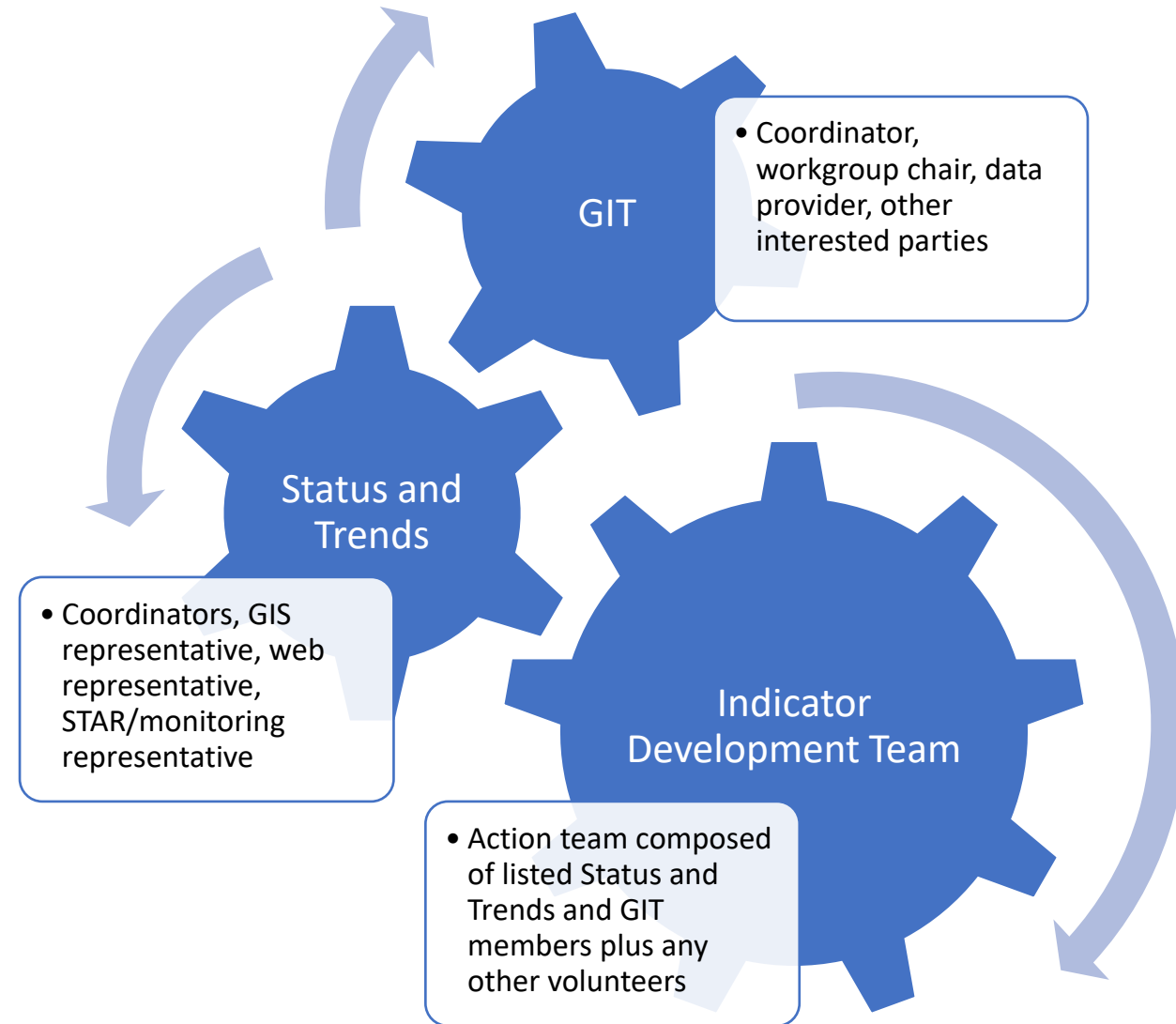

Current Indicator Update Process



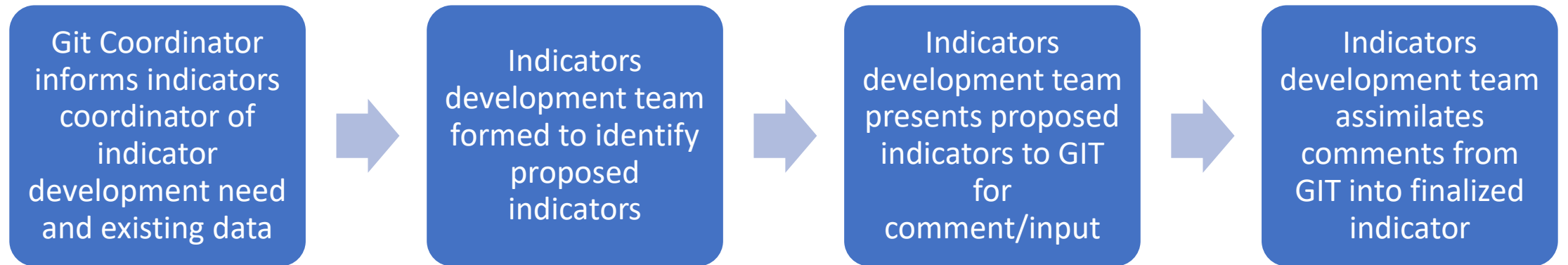

- “Indicators coordinator” could be either of the STWG coordinators
 - With 2 STWG coordinators, each can chair different action teams to serve in this role
- Under this model, there is no need for final approval from STWG because proper representation is on action team
- Length of timeline will vary depending on current status of indicator
