#### **Wetlands Challenges**

#### **Tracking**

There needs to be a system in place to track wetlands lost and long-term monitoring of restoration projects.

#### **Funding**

There is a lack of financial drivers to increase wetland restoration at the scale necessary to meet goals.

## Lack of Consistency

There is a need for a list of practices that count towards restoration and enhancement with guidance on how to calculate acres restored.

#### Capacity

There is a need for long term capacity/more expertise in wetland design, permitting, and implementation.

#### **Outreach**

Outreach and education geared towards landowners.
