# 1:10 pm Update on Chesapeake Bay Program (CBP) Climate Change Activities and Next Steps to Develop and Finalize the Biennial Work Plan

Building off progress made during the Work Group's June 8, 2015 meeting, the development of the Work Plan, which will guide implementation of the Climate Resiliency Management Strategy over the next two years, is one of primary areas of focus for the Work Group between now and December, 2015. We will be discussing the proposed process and timeline for completion of the Work Plan, including the need to finalize performance targets; identify participating entities; set timelines; and estimate implementation costs.

We will also be discussing the formation of a core group of Work Group members, comprised of representatives of state-signatories, the Chesapeake Bay Commission, appropriate CBP Work Groups (STAC, STAR, LGAC, CAC) and Federal Agencies, as well as interested parties, which will take the lead helping to draft and finalize the Work Plan in the coming months.

# 2:40 pm GIT Funding Proposals

The CBP is offering \$840,000 for fiscal year 2015 to support projects proposed by CBP Goal Implementation Teams, Workgroups and Action Teams that will enable completion of the Management Strategies. EPA is providing this funding for projects that support program goals, outcomes, management strategies, and workplans.

The Climate Change Work Group will discuss potential proposals for the GIT funding, due by September 7, 2015.
