In response to CBP partnership's interest in developing and implementing alternative approaches for the verification of agricultural BMPs, Mark Dubin, UMD and Jon Harcum, Tetra Tech, presented a draft recommendation report regarding the development of an alternate BMP verification evaluation standard for producer surveys as part of the effort in seeking CBP partnership approval of alternative verification methods for use in the CBP Phase 6 modeling tools. The AgWG was asked to review the document and submit comments to Mark Dubin and Lindsey Gordon, CRC by March 1<sup>st</sup>.

<u>Decision</u>: The AgWG will be asked to approve the draft recommendation report regarding the development of an alternate BMP verification evaluation standard for producer surveys.
