State Lands Watershed Implementation Plan

- State agencies and public institutions of higher education shall prepare agency-wide plans for the protection and restoration of tree canopies and riparian forest buffers.
- Focused on parcels greater than 5 acres.
- BMPs for reducing nutrient and sediment loss will be employed on all state lands [in active cultivation or] supporting animal agriculture including pastures.

Department of Environmental Quality Water Permitting Focus on RFB

- 2022 Report to General Assembly <u>https://rga.lis.virginia.gov/Published/2022/RD43/PDF</u>
- Continuing to study the preservation/conservation of existing tree canopy that is not already deemed forest/open space as a fourth land-cover category within the Virginia Runoff Reduction Method.
- Developing a new BMP called "New Trees."
- Reconvening the SAG, or a subset thereof that includes technical experts and VSMP authorities, to continue the work thus far initiated.
