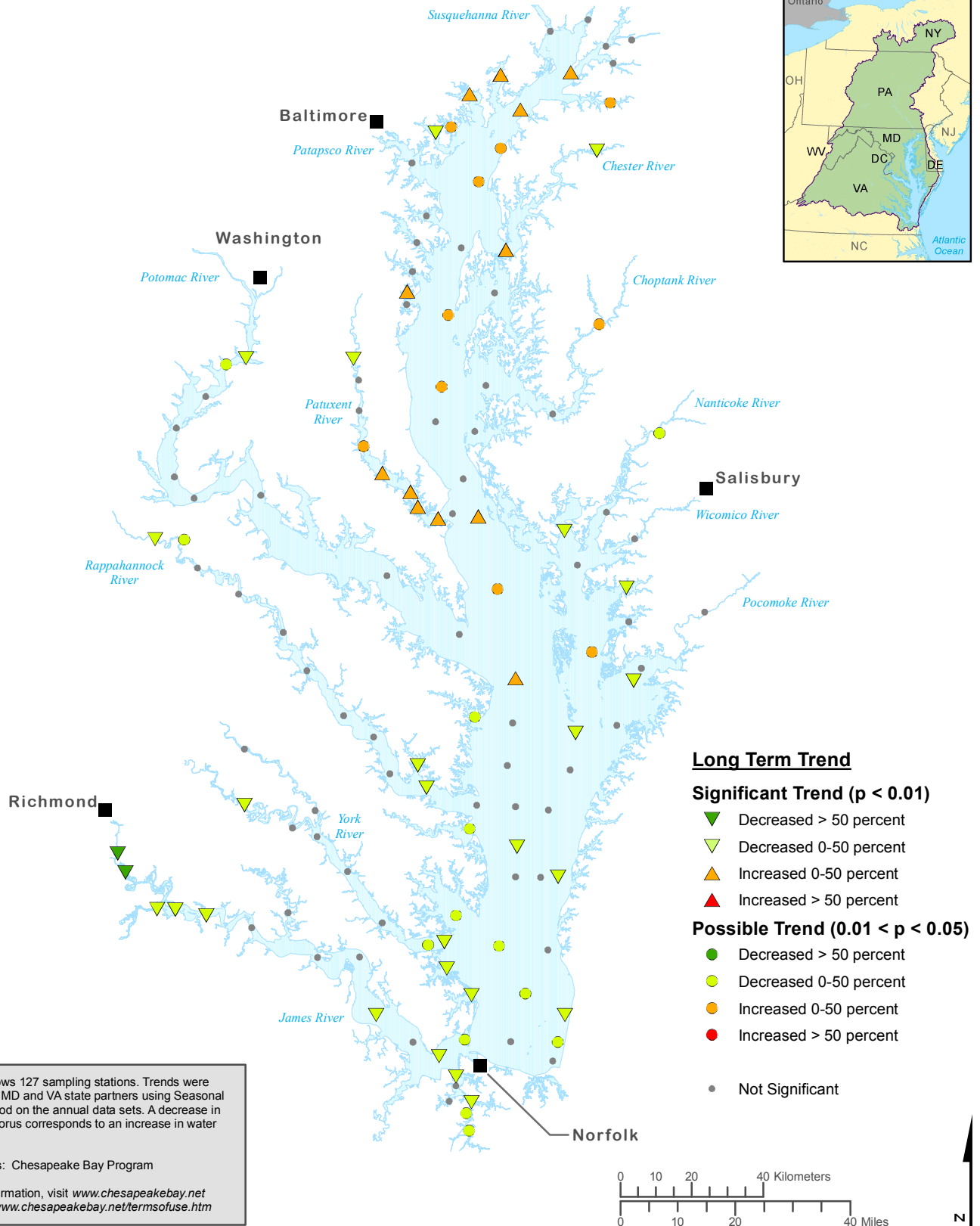


Long-Term Trends for Bottom Total Phosphorus in the Chesapeake Bay: 1999-2013



This map shows 127 sampling stations. Trends were computed by MD and VA state partners using Seasonal Kendall method on the annual data sets. A decrease in Total Phosphorus corresponds to an increase in water quality.
