FY2014 CBP Budget

- FY13 (\$54 mil) FY14 (\$70 mil)
- State Grants
 - Almost 80% of increase going to state grants
 - Local government "set-aside" for implementation (\$5 mil)
 - Increase for New Agreement implementation
 - Headwaters states
 - Signatory states
 - Restore monitoring funding to FY12 levels (\$4.8 mil + \$300k SAV)
 - \$5 mil for Innovative and \$5 mil for Small Watershed grants

FY2014 CBP Budget

- Other Investment Areas
 - Goal Implementation Team Support (\$750k)
 - Management Strategy Development
 - Implementation Projects & Tools
 - BMP Expert Panels
 - BMP Verification Programs
 - CAST/FAST Tools
 - Climate Change
 - Citizen Monitoring Initiative
 - Financing Workshops
 - Trading Program Support (\$1 mil)
- FY2015 \$73 million PresBud Request
