# GIT-Funding Project Update

"Cultivating and Strengthening Relationships with Underrepresented Stakeholders"

- Project Lead: Chesapeake Conservancy
- Bi-weekly meetings between Chesapeake Conservancy and Diversity Workgroup (two meetings held thus far)
- Focus groups:
  - Currently identifying target audiences and drafting questions
  - Focus groups to start meeting in June or July
- Late start due to high number of project applicants

#### Next Steps

April-June: Compile and incorporate internal CBP feedback from Action Team,
 Diversity Workgroup, and Partnership entities into plan redraft.

#### June-August:

- Outreach: Direct engagement with underrepresented communities via Action Team members and partner networks; public comment period; community meetings and conferences.
- Tracking/Reporting Framework: Develop proposal for implementation tracking and reporting framework. Will seek input from jurisdictions and partner organizations on overall feasibility and continuity with their DEIJ plans.
- August-September: Compile and incorporate feedback into plan redraft. Final recommendations on community integration into CBP structure.
