


Chesapeake Bay Basin - 2014 Riparian Buffers 1 Dot = 25 CRP Acres

Payments also include up-front signing incentive of \$150 per acre and practice incentive equal to 40% of installation cost.

- 1/ Delaware pays part of the incentive up-front.
- 2/ Maryland also pays a one-time incentive of \$100 per acre.
- 3/ Virginia also pays a one-time incentive of \$75 per acre.
- 4/ West Virginia also pays a one-time incentive equal to one year's annual rental payment.
