GIS Onsite Septic Database Overview

The ArcSDE layer, sde.SV_DE_SEPTICNUTRIENTQUERY is a live layer pointing directly to the septic permitting data. That means once it is inputted it is available to be seen spatially. Each time the dataset is viewed it shows all the data at the point of query in the very far right last field.

Permit Status description that show a system is in the ground would be:

Completion Report Received = we've received the post installation construction information from the contractor.

Class H System Inspection = The system is in the ground and was inspected by DNREC or a licensed inspector.

A status of Call Notification Received means construction is eminent.

The following status descriptions indicate the permit is pending approval:

Application Received

Application Returned

Pending

On Hold

Approved indicates the system may be constructed but we have not received notification that construction will start not has the permit expired.

The following description indicate the system will not be constructed for various reasons:

Denied

Expired

Revoked

Void

Withdrawn

Suspended

Abandoned indicates the system was constructed and now was abandoned.

Issues, some data inputted do not contain any dates of when approved/constructed happenedThere are dwellings out there not in sewer districts that haven't been picked up at all. They will most likely be picked up eventually by Class H Inspections. Picture below represents sites not picked up by database (in green). Points in red mean not picked up (Issue would be including poultry houses/sheds/disconnected garages).
