- 1 Strive for fairness, equity, and feasibility among partners participating in the Conowingo WIP regarding level of effort, financing, tracking, resource sharing, and third party access;
- 2 Strive for consensus using the Chesapeake Bay Program Partnership Consensus Continuum as described in the document, "Governance and Management Framework for the Chesapeake Bay Program Partnership". When consensus cannot be reached, the issue will be deferred to the PSC with a summary of the issue and the different options and opinions expressed by the members.
- 3. Ensure consistency with the EPA expectations and Conowingo WIP framework documents.
- 4. Establish clear tracking, accountability and verification consistent with expectations for jurisdictions and to transparently demonstrate which practices are planned for, implemented and maintained in the Conowingo WIP vs state WIPs in order to avoid double-counting.
- 5 Implement the Conowingo WIP building on existing, successful programs, as much as is feasible, to avoid creating duplicative bureaucracies. At the same time, strive for innovation, leverage new technologies, and, where appropriate, develop new implementation approaches.
