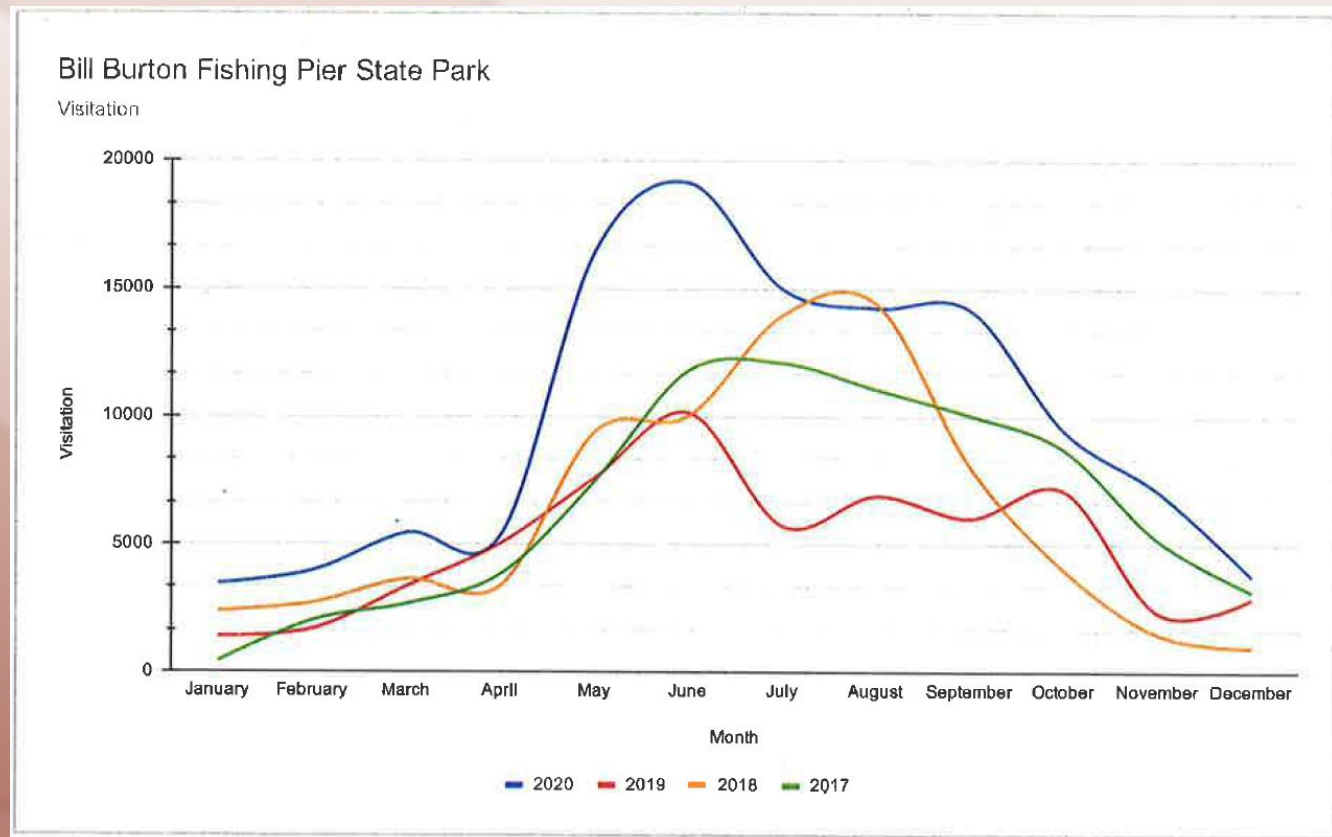

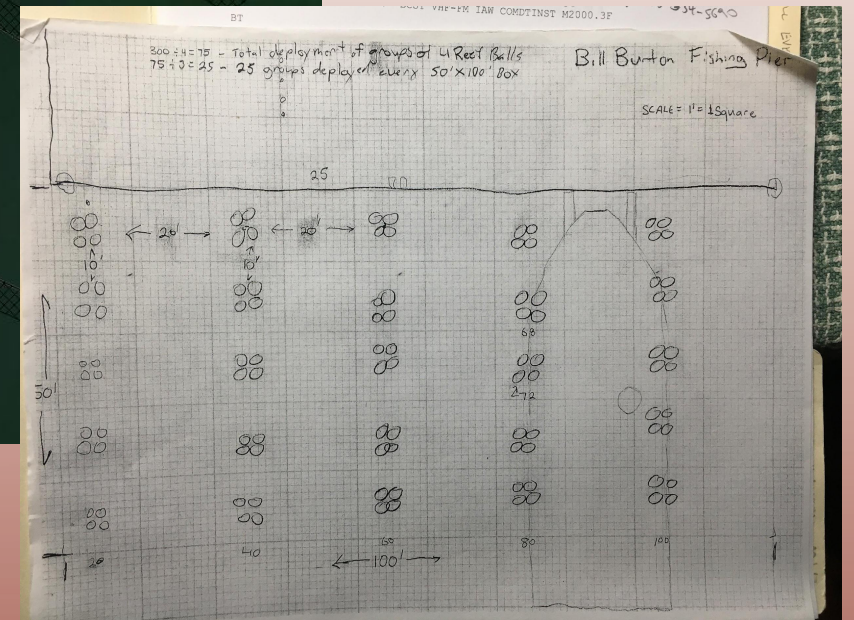
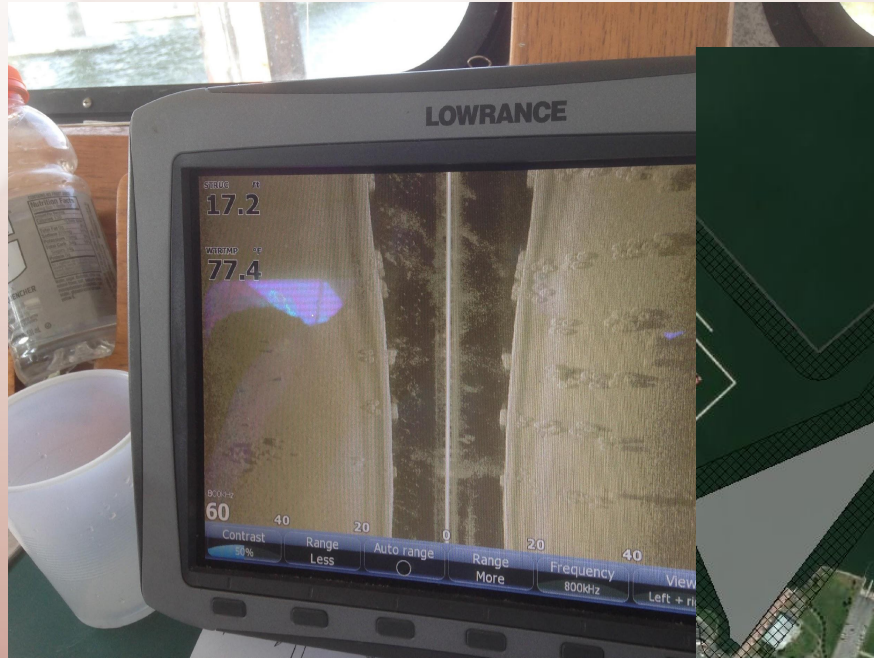
Existing Resources - Pier

- Perch, spot, striped bass, catfish, crabs, croaker



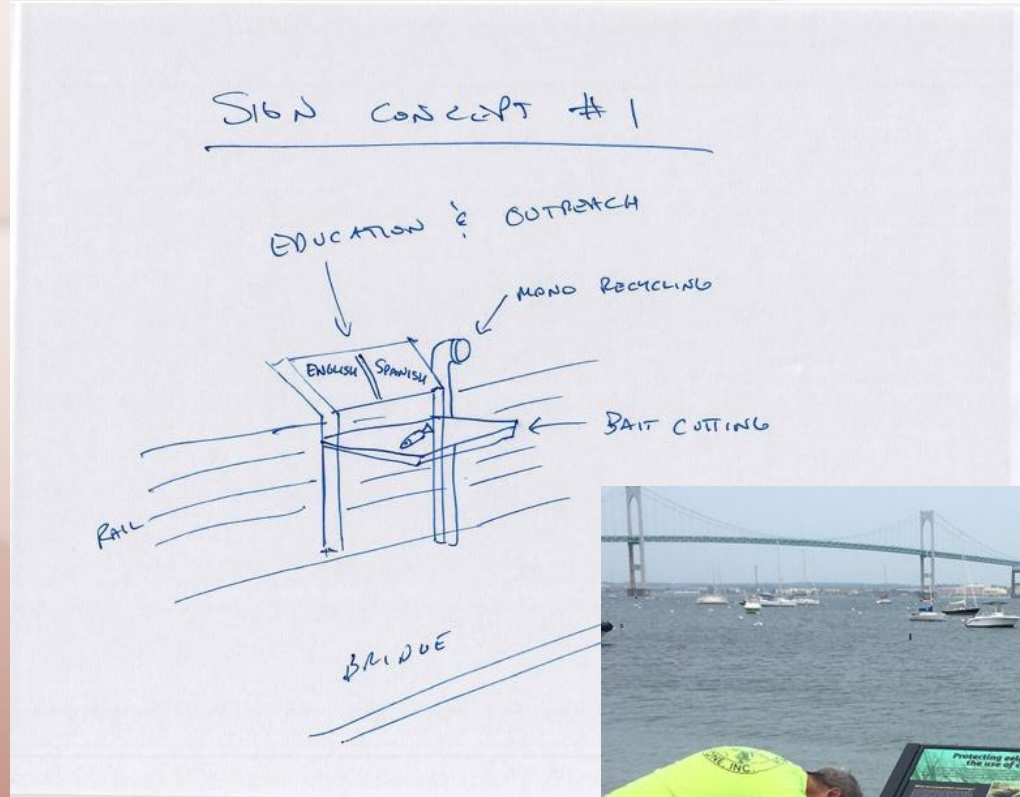
Existing Resources - Habitat
