Your report will detail the composition of your property, the natural benefits provided by your property, and your potential to benefit from conservation programs and to receive payments for enhancing the natural benefits

Owners of even small acreages can make a positive difference in their environment through planning and implementing simple stewardship practices learned at this workshop.


