Actions/Decisions

Funding Updates

- Note: EPA/CBPO staff plans to meet with all the jurisdictions this summer to begin planning for FY23.
- Note: Information about the additional \$7.7M IJA funding for advancing forest buffer outcomes and assessment will be shared during the July 19 PSC meeting.

EC Planning

- Action: CBP staff will begin looking for venues in DC for the fall EC meeting.
- Action: Rachel Felver (CBP Communications Director) will incorporate the ideas raised during the May PSC meeting into the discussion at the next Executive Council Planning Committee Meeting.

Changes to CAST 2021

- Action: The Modeling team will provide an update on the CAST 2021 release timeline in the coming weeks with an expected release in July/mid-summer.

Monitoring Funding Needs

- Action: The monitoring team will work with jurisdictional partners and others to combine resources to share the needs of the monitoring network.
- Action: The PSC will identify monitoring program managers who are positioned to discuss and address budgetary concerns. These program managers will attend a kickoff meeting where they will begin to implement short-term and long-term recommendations of the monitoring team and PSC.
- Action: The team of monitoring program managers will report to the PSC annually to provide a progress update on monitoring investment and implementation efforts.
- Action: STAR will coordinate development and maintenance of new network portfolios.

Accelerating Progress on Wetlands and Forest Buffers

- Action: Wetlands – Workshops are scheduled for August 2-3. PSC members are asked to identify key people from their jurisdictions to participate in the workshops. Participant nominations should be sent to Melanie Davenport (melanie.davenport@deq.virginia.gov) and Katlyn Fuentes (fuentes.katlyn@epa.gov) by May 31.
- Action: Forest Buffers – The PSC voiced support for making Riparian Forest Buffers a standing item on future PSC meeting agendas. The Riparian Forest Buffers team would like to use their time during the July 19 PSC meeting to articulate specific actions the partners can take.
