- ACTION: (No lead) GIT 6 is forming a small group to help plan an effective discussion during the next two GIT 6 meetings on CBP Organizational Analysis. CBP Director, Dana Aunkst, will be invited to the October and December GIT 6 meetings to focus on the CBP Organizational Analysis topic.
- ACTION: (No lead) GIT 6 is seeking volunteers to conduct an affinity analysis on the GIT SRS surveys.
   This analysis would show a clear connection to between the pain points identified in the surveys and the improvements being made through ChesapeakeDecisions.

If the Management Board accepts the presentation as a finance pilot for other outcomes, then the discussion will continue on how to advance this GIT Funding project.

  information on the CBP website in a way that you could click on a person's name and see all the
  groups they are members of under their individual "profile." In progress.
