Actions & Decisions

Program Updates

<u>Note</u>: Nicki Kasi was introduced as the new Program Manager for the Chesapeake Bay Office in Pennsylvania's Water Programs Deputate.

<u>Note</u>: The Habitat Goal Team has a new chair, Christine Conn and vice-chair, David Whitehurst. <u>Note</u>: Rachel Felver is the new CBP communication's director.

I. Chesapeake Decisions Discovery

<u>Note</u>: The morning session of the MB meeting was a series of exercises to help in the discovery process for a potential new CBP web tool, "Chesapeake Decisions". A summary of the discovery process will be provided to the MB when completed.

II. 2016 State Legislative Actions

A. Midpoint Assessment Update

 would like feedback from the partners about when they want to engage on certain
 issues (like Conowingo, climate change), receive briefings and otherwise stay engaged.
- <u>Action</u>: Additional detail about scheduling changes will be provided to the MB at their April meeting. In progress.
- <u>Decision</u>: The presentation on midpoint assessment was accepted as guidance.
