






State-identified Healthy Waters and Watersheds (2015)






Stream Health: Average Indicator of Biotic Integrity Ratings of 10,000+ Sampling Sites (2000-2010)




Stream Health, 2000-2010






Protected Lands (2015-2016)




Protected Lands (By Jurisdiction), 2011-2015/2016
