

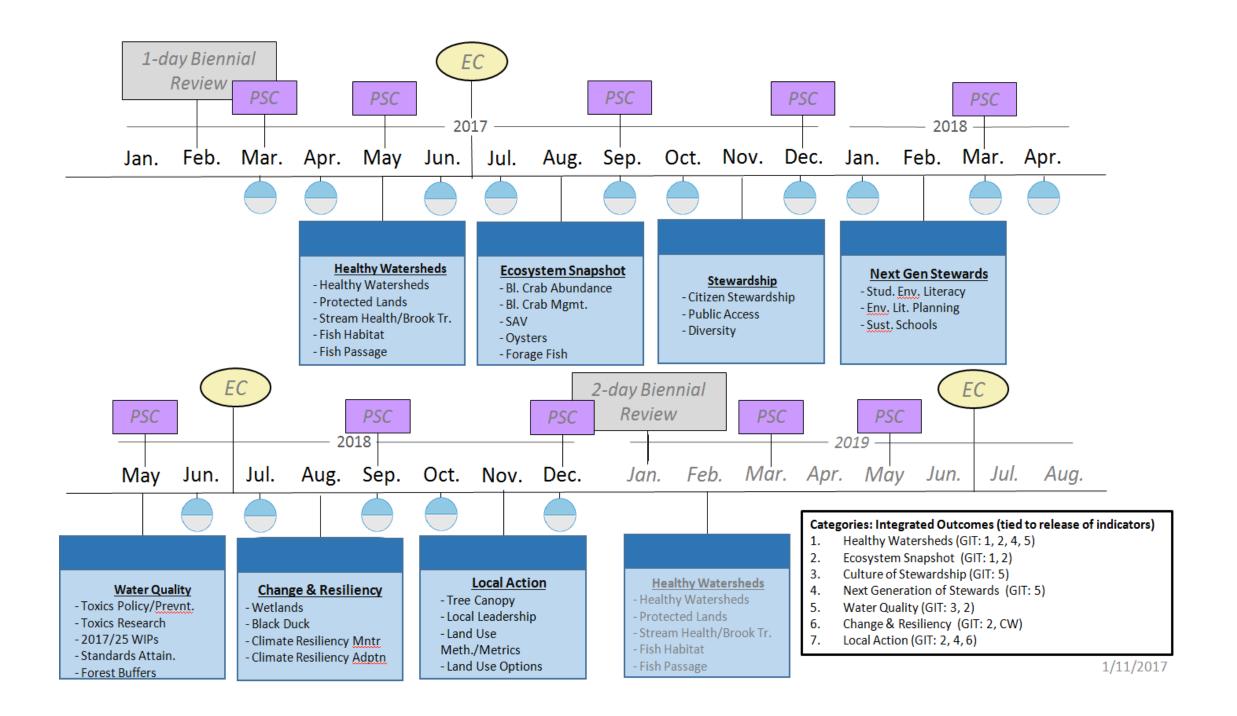

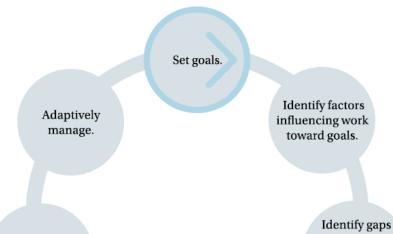

What actions are essential to achieve our outcome?	Optional: Do we have a measure of progress? How do we know if we have achieved the intended result?	Optional: What effects do we expect to see as a result of this action, when, and what is the anticipated application of these changes?	Optional: What did we learn from taking this action? How will this lesson impact our work?

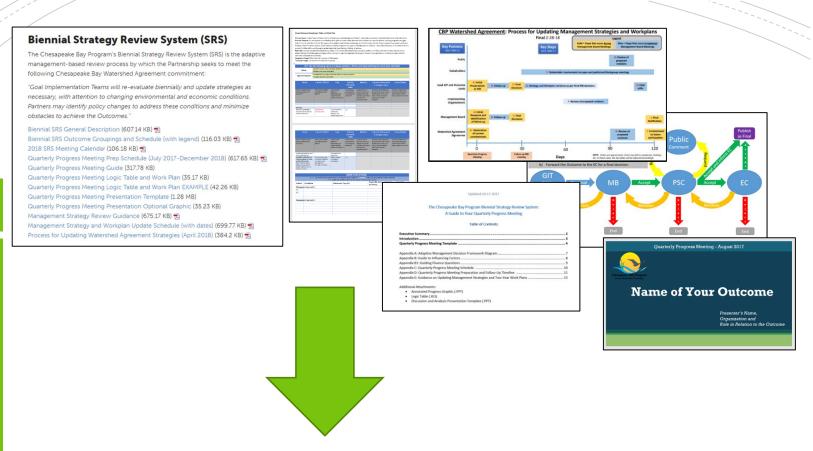
