#### **MINUTES**

#### 1. Welcome and Introductions

• Karl Berger, co-chair, welcomed everyone to the meeting and confirmed participants both in person and on the conference line.

## 2. Forecasting in Delaware

Carol Bason presented an overview of forecasting methodology (Presentation link).

## 3. COG Regional Forecasting Methodology

- Paul DesJardin and Greg Goodwin presented Washington Metropolitan COG's method of forecasting population, employment and housing (COG link).
- Peter Claggett: Have used these forecasts in the past, to estimate population in the COG region. Use MD and VA numbers for areas outside the COG region.
- Baltimore Metro Council has a similar forecasting process, three jurisdictions are overlapping. COG uses BMC estimates for this overlap.
- Claggett: Are the reasons for population change explored?
  - i. COG focuses more on housing and employment than on population. Population is derivative of housing population.

#### 4. Forecasting in Maryland

- Stephanie Martins, MDP, presented the Maryland Department of Planning approach to forecasting. (Stephanie's presentation).
- Pat Buckley: PA is in support of using the most current land use rather than a 2025 projection. PA does not currently have a projection method, another state's method may not be applicable to PA.

#### 5. CBPO Forecasting

- Peter Claggett and Renee Thompson, USGS, presented the CBPO methodology for forecasting and measuring infill (Peter's link/no Renee link).
- Determining the trend between housing density and land area, could be done at the state level, with unique trends based on each state's data.

## 6. Agricultural Forecasting

- Jim Baird, American Farmland Trust, gave an overview of the proposed agricultural forecasting subcommittee, which will convene pending approval by the Water Quality Goal Team.
- Berger: Potential intersection with this group's responsibilities, in terms of ag land use acres, request coordination between the groups.

- Karl Berger led a discussion of upcoming meeting topics.
- Request that members weigh in on forecasting methodology with their recommendations.
- Request that Peter summarize the suggested principles for the acceptance of forecasted or any land use within the partnership.
