
Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement Management Strategies Development

Following the adoption of the Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement, Chesapeake Bay Program Goal Implementation Teams will spend one year developing management strategies for the outcomes that support the agreement's goals. These strategies will outline the means for accomplishing the outcome(s) and for monitoring, assessing and reporting progress. The adoption of these strategies may vary by signatory, and the implementation will take place in two-year periods. Stakeholder input will be essential to their development and evaluation, which will take place every two years: each strategy will include a period for public review and comment before it is adopted.





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
