Mr. Mullins has worked in the areas of nutrient management environmental regulation of agriculture for 14 years. He is a certified nutrient management planner in Virginia and has a master's degree in Crop and Soil Environmental Science from Virginia Tech.

Seth worked for VA DCR as the Nutrient Management Coordinator for animal waste from 2005 – 2008 where he was responsible for the review of nutrient management plans written for animal feeding operations permitted by VA DEQ and conducted the required continuing education training for permitted farmers across the state. He also assisted the program in conducting training of new and existing certified plan writers.

In 2008, he began work at VA DEQ conducting compliance inspections at VPA permitted animal feeding operations and biosolids land application sites. He has conducted thousands of inspections on widely varying farming operations. Over time, that position evolved and took on the additional responsibility of permitting. He has written both VPA and VPDES permits for facilities ranging from dairy farms to industrial sites land applying wastewater. More recently, compliance inspections on various VPDES permitted facilities were added to the list of job duties.
